

# Commercial License Agreement - Ars Moriendi 3D

These terms apply to the digital products designed by:

## 1. GRANT OF LICENSE

Upon signing up to the Patreon tier "Mythic Merchant", the commercial license agreement is granted by Ars Moriendi 3D to the individual purchasing the license. You agree to read and abide to the following conditions in this license agreement, in order to be an officially licensed seller of the designs made by Ars Moriendi 3D.

The license is active for as long as you are signed up to the Mythic Merchant tier on Patreon. As soon as you no longer are signed up to the Mythic Merchant Patreon tier, you are no longer permitted to sell any of Ars Moriendi 3D's designs.

You understand and agree that the Patreon tier "Mythic Merchant" only provides you with a commercial license, and does not include monthly file deliveries. Digital files can be acquired from our website: http://arsmoriendi3d.com/, our Cults3D profile: https://cults3d.com/en/users/ArsMoriendi3D or from our Kickstarter campaigns. Any free and purchased files are upgraded to a commercial license.

We reserve the right to withdraw the commercial license and will do so with a notification at least 3 months in advance. In the unforeseen event that Patreon ceases to provide us with a

platform to distribute licenses from, the commercial license will cease.

We reserve the right to cancel a license at any time in the case of misuse or breach of agreement.

## 2. RIGHTS

You are allowed to sell physical prints from Ars Moriendi 3D's designs, unless otherwise noted in this section.

There are currently no exceptions.

We may add exceptions in the events of cross promotion, fanart, commissions, charity events, etc.

#### 3. LIMITATIONS

This license grants a single user from a single location the rights to sell physical 3D-prints. You do not have the right to resell, transfer, upload or sub-license any of the digital files.

Actions contrary to the above rights may result in prosecution.

Injection molds and large scale mass production is prohibited.

However, mold making is permitted, but only upon our written approval. Only one mold is allowed at a time per individual design, including any variations of it. Each mold is allowed to produce no more than 20 casts per month.

These terms for mold making are susceptible to change in the case of misuse or any unforeseen events. In that case we reserve the rights to cancel any written approval, effective immediately.

### 4. MODIFICATIONS

It is not permitted to modify our designs. Exceptions may be made upon request, as long as the request is not changing the overall appearance and expression of a design. Using part of a model to create a new model is prohibited.

### 5. CREDIT

You agree to credit Ars Moriendi 3D by using the unique Merchant's number you have been provided with. This number is provided by us and must be used either as a watermark on at least one of your sales images or as a stand alone image in each individual sales page/listing. The provided Merchant's number must be readible.

Use of Ars Moriendi 3D's logo is permitted and optional. Visually altering or covering the logo is prohibited.

We will provide you with rendered images through Patreon which you are allowed to use.

### 6. MALFUNCTION

The items purchased on arsmoriendi3d.com constitute only drawings for the execution of printing on a 3D printer, but do not constitute any real technical drawings and Ars Moriendi 3D cannot be held responsible for any errors as a result of the use of drawings.

#### 7. COMPLAINTS

If you have any complaints, please contact us via e-mail contact@arsmoriendi3d.com and we will try to find a solution to the problem. If you are not satisfied with our processing you have the right to complaint.
